# Introduction Helpful information about the bursary



### What is a Wheatley Foundation Bursary?

A Wheatley Foundation bursary is a grant that customers living in our homes can apply for to support them to achieve their educational goals and help them on the career path they wish to undertake. It will also aim to offer employability support like CV support and internships where appropriate.

### Who can apply?

Applicants living in a GHA, Dunedin Canmore, Cube, Loretto Housing, West Lothian Housing Partnership, Barony Housing or Your Place property who have applied to study a HNC, HND, undergraduate degree or one year postgraduate course (no higher than Level 11 on the Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework).

### When can I apply?

Applications can be made from 15 April 2019 – 30 June 2019.

### How much can be applied for?

The bursary will offer support of £1,500 to Full-Time students and £750 to Part-Time students. Bursary support will be offered for up to 2 years at the discretion of the awarding Wheatley Foundation employees.

### What can we fund?

A bursary award can support you for the costs of books, equipment, travel costs, childcare or other living costs that will help you to complete a course.

### When will the bursary be paid?

The bursary will be paid across 4 instalments during the academic year: September, November, January, March.

### Does it need to be paid back?

The bursary is a grant and does not need to be paid back. Will the bursary affect applications for SAAS or housing benefit payments? Receiving a Wheatley Foundation bursary should not affect a student's entitlement to SAAS funding or housing benefit payments as it is a charitable donation.

### Who decides if I get a bursary?

There are a limited number of bursaries available. Applications will be assessed against a set criteria by Wheatley Foundation employees. Decisions on applications will be made after 30th June 2019 and you will receive notice of your application outcome after this date.
